AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$263,091.00 FROM THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF OVERTIME FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A CRASH INVESTIGATION SOFTWARE LICENSE, STALKER RADAR UNITS, LETSAC CONFERENCE FEES AND HAZARDOUS MOVING VIOLATIONS ENFORCEMENT FROM OCTOBER 1, 2020, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; AUTHORIZING FUTURE CHANGE ORDERS, EXTENSIONS, AMENDMENTS OR ADDENDUMS FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE SAME PROJECT AND MAKING THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Independence, Missouri, finds it in the best interests of the City to make an effort to create and maintain as safe an atmosphere as possible for the motoring public; and,

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation, Highway Safety Division, has offered a grant to the City of Independence for reimbursement of overtime for the Police Department for a Crash Investigation Software License, Stalker Radar Units, LETSAC Conference fees and hazardous moving violations enforcement in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Ninety One and 00/100 Dollars (\$263,091.00) from October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council does wish to accept this grant and has concluded the grant conditions can be met;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby directs the City Manager of the City of Independence, Missouri, to accept the grant (Project #21-PT-02-035) from the Missouri Department of Transportation and sign a contract for reimbursement to the City in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Ninety One and 00/100 Dollars (\$263,091.00) for a Crash Investigation Software License, Stalker Radar Units, LETSAC Conference fees and overtime for the Police Department from October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021, to provide enforcement with an emphasis on hazardous moving violations, a copy of which is attached hereto, incorporated by reference thereto, and made a part hereof as though fully set out herein.

SECTION 2. That appropriations are hereby increased in the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year Grant Fund Police Department Operating Budget in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Ninety One and 00/100 Dollars (\$263,091.00) from increased Estimated Revenues from a Grant from the Missouri Department of Transportation, Highway Safety Division, for a Crash Investigation Software License, Radar Units, LETSAC Conference fees and an overtime program for hazardous moving violations enforcement that also include aggressive driving violations, red light violations.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is further authorized to approve future change orders, extensions, amendments or addendums to this contract without Council approval, for an extension of time for completing the terms of this contract or for the receipt of additional funding for this project, provided there are no changes in the responsibilities to the City and provided each and every such change order, extension, amendment or addendum is approved by the City Manager, does not add more than 90% to the length of the contract or more than 50% to the original funding, is identified as being authorized by this ordinance and a copy is filed with the City Clerk.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations by the amount of any increases authorized by change order, extension, amendment or addendum for any increased funding under the terms of the previous section provided a copy of that action is also provided to the Finance Department.
