

General Notes:

- final payment.

 2) All driveways on north side of Walnut from Haden St, to Lee's Summit Rd, to be repaired with 6" of reinforced concrete (4000 pst) from street to R/W. See detail.

 3) Contractor to make all road repairs and cleanup per City of Independence requirements.

 4) Contractor will be responsible for any plates that may be required to allow road to remain open.

 5) Water Department will be responsible for operating all valves and re-filling water mains.

 6) Contractor responsible for pot-holing all existing utility lines and sanitary sewer lines to determine depits in conflict with water mains.

 7) Contractor responsible for removal of all existing utility lines and sanitary sewer lines to service lines have been changed over to new water mains per detail.

 8) Contractor responsible for removing all existing fire hydrants, valve boxes on abandoned main once new water main is in service. Contractor responsible for making all repairs where fire hydrants and valve boxes have been removed.

 9) Contractor responsible for making sure all culvert pipes are clear of debris and able to flow water. If not contractor is to clean out culvert pipes, as needed.

 10) Contractor to wipe down all piping at tie-in points with 50ppm HTH.
