AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020- 2021 BUDGET, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY ORDINANCE NO. 19131.

WHEREAS, the adopted Operating and Capital budgets for the 2020-2021 fiscal year were approved by the City Council by Ordinance No. 19131; and,

WHEREAS, since that time some circumstances have arisen that necessitate changes to the appropriations established in the adopted budget; and,

WHEREAS, these changes are listed in detail in terms of background, purpose and funding source in the attached agenda item cover sheet;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$25,249.99 from various grants and donations for Police programs and services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$25,249.99 to the Police Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
- SECTION 2. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$12,000.00 from various grants and donations for Animal Service programs and services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$12,000.00 to the Animal Service Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$44,839.20 from Police Forfeiture revenues in the General Fund (No. 002) to Police Forfeiture expenditures in the General Fund (No. 002).
- SECTION 4. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$1,055,998.00 from grants for Parks, Recreation, and Tourism programs and services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$1,055,998.00 to the Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
- SECTION 5. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$6,336.00 from the trade-in of Police assets in the General Fund (No. 002) and appropriating a total of \$6,336.00 for replacement assets for Police in the General Fund (No. 002).
- SECTION 6. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$14,000.00 from the Health & Recreation tax levy in the Health Property Tax Levy Fund for Animal Services (No. 005) and appropriating a total of \$14,000 in the Health Property Tax Levy Fund for Animal Services (No. 005).
- SECTION 7. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$29,700.00 from the Health & Recreation tax levy in the Health Property Tax Levy Fund for Parks, Recreation, and Tourism (No. 007) and appropriating a total of \$29,700 in the Health Property Tax Levy Fund for Parks, Recreation, and Tourism (No. 007).
- <u>SECTION 8.</u> Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$1,400,000.00 in the Water Fund (No. 040) as a result of increased expenditures related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- SECTION 9. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$100,800.00 from Events Center billboard rental in the Buildings and Other Improvements Fund (No. 057) and appropriating a total of \$100,800.00 in the Buildings and Other Improvements Fund (No. 057).

<u>SECTION 10</u>. Transferring appropriations in the amount of 634,625.16 within the Sanitary Sewer Fund (No. 030) for the following projects:
