These are the ongoing traffic safety grants that are renewed for each year. These grant requests are for the 2021/2022 grant year beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and ending September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

In addition to the online submission, the attached original hard copy applications require Chief Halsey's signature. The attached authorization form requires approval by the City Manager. This paperwork will be submitted by mail and accepted by MODOT Highway Safety Division after the March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 deadline for online submission.
