A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUSPEND FOR 30 DAYS THE INCREASE TO THE FUEL COST ADJUSTMENT RESULTING FROM WINTER STORM URI IN FEBRUARY EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2021.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Rate Schedule was made effective on October 1, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, rate schedule has included a Fuel Cost Adjustment since the 1970's to account for fluctuations in fuel and purchased power costs; and,

WHEREAS, Power and Light incurred extraordinary, purchased power and fuel costs in the month of February resulting from Winter Storm Uri; and,

WHEREAS, the Fuel Cost Adjustment was increased by 1.79 cents/kWh pursuant to the approved Rate Schedule; and,

WHEREAS, half of all billing cycles have already been billed for the month of April reflecting this increase; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to suspend this increase for 30 days, effective May 1, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is directed to suspend the FCA increase for 30 days effective May 1, 2021.
