THE TYPICAL REVOCATION LEVEL IS AFTER THREE OR FOUR VIOLATIONS, DEPENDING ON THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE SALES. THIS LOCATION HAS REPEATEDLY FAILED TO TRAIN ITS EMPLOYEES AND, AS A RESULT, THERE HAVE BEEN TOO MANY VIOLATIONS AT THIS STORE. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT BELIEVE THAT A SIMPLE "SALE" OF THE BUSINESS OR "TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP" WILL CORRECT THE PROBLEM.
