



### Fire Trends / Challenges:

- 2020 Total Incidents 23412
  - **3.8%** Increase from 2019 (22526)
  - ○33% Increase since 2009 (15630)



### Fire Trends / Challenges:

- Total Apparatus Runs 30,305
  - ○3.5% Increase from 2019 (29,255)
  - ○40% Increase since 2009 (18276)
  - 11 of 14 companies >2000 responses for the 2020 calendar year





### **CLASSROOM TRAINING FACILITY**

- Tower Built 2001
- O Classroom Facilities cut from original design
- Needed for more all-weather training and restroom facilities.
- O Potential site for station replacement

### **CURRENT FUNDING**

- OPublic Safety Sales Tax Fire
  - One-eight of one percent approved from 2017 to 2028
  - OFor the purpose of providing for purchase, construction, repair, maintenance and reconstruction of facilities and equipment and for training within the operation of the municipal fire department
- General Fund

### **FUTURE SALES TAX?**

ORsMo 321.242

The governing body of any municipality having a municipal fire department may impose a sales tax in an amount of up to one-half of one percent on all retail sales made in such fire protection district or municipality which are subject to taxation....
