A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ADVISORY BOARD HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON IPL NEW GENERATION

WHEREAS, Independence Power and Light is a municipal public utility subject to local control; and,

WHEREAS, the City is considering a potential investment of between \$50 to \$100 million for potential new generation to replace six combustion turbines; and,

WHEREAS, this is a major capital expenditure for the city to undertake; perhaps the largest in the city's history; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved a \$125,000 siting study which will result in the development of a Request for Proposal for new generation; and,

WHEREAS, the City Charter permits the Public Utilities Advisory Board (PUAB) to hold public hearings under Section 3.14 (5) of the City Charter which states:

May conduct public hearings on matters relating to public utilities and, through its chairperson, administer oaths and affirmations

WHEREAS, the recent joint meeting of the City Council and the PUAB included a discussion on the advisability of the PUAB holding public hearings in general and specifically the new generation project; and,

WHEREAS, it would be helpful to the City Council for the PUAB to hold a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Requests the PUAB to hold a public hearing on plans for generation plan sometime this summer.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The public hearing is to focus on the new generation including how new power is generated, financing of the project and its potential impact on current utility rates.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Public Utility Advisory Board should also provide a period fifteen (15) days after the close of the public hearing for the rate payers, Independence residents and interested members of the broader public to submit written comments regarding the subject of the public hearing, which comments shall be attached to and become a part of the public hearing's official record.
