# Operational Changes for Parks & Municipal Services

## Introduction

Over the last year, the Municipal Services Department and the Parks, Recreation & Tourism Department discussed ways to improve City services:

- Mowing
- Landscaping & tree maintenance at City owned sites
- Asphalt and concrete repairs

## Goal

The goal for these discussions was focused on reviewing current practices:

- Efficiency
- Centralizing services
- Reduce or eliminate duplication of services

Solutions are found through: Collaboration – We get more done when we work across departments

## History

- The majority of mowing used to be performed by the Parks Department
  - Around 2003 Right-of-way mowing was shifted to the Public Works Department
- Landscaping and tree maintenance was historically performed by both Departments
- Concrete work was performed by both Departments; Parks used contractors for asphalt work on parking lots and trails; Street Maintenance did in-house asphalt work on City streets

## Implementation

#### **PARKS**

- Mowing, landscaping and tree work at City facilities previously done by M.S.
- 3 FTE's shifted from M.S. to Parks for right-of-way mowing, but available for snow removal operations; mowing equipment transferred

#### **MUNICIPAL SERVICES**

Hardscape maintenance: cost for materials paid for by Parks

## Examples - Mowing

- Bass Pro Dr. Parks mowed one side of the street and M.S. the other side of the street
- Trail from Rotary Park to Country Club Park Parks mowed along the trail but M.S. mowed the City owned lots adjacent to the trail
- City Hall & Police Building Parks was already mowing Hiram Young Park across the street



## Examples – Landscaping/Trees

- Parks has a Horticulturalist on staff
- Parks already has equipment for tree maintenance
- Parks tries to salvage trees rather than removing them



## Examples – Asphalt/Concrete

- Concrete flatwork
- Asphalt parking lot maintenance
- Trail maintenance
