**Any property not stored or moved  
from within 200 feet of this notice by the scheduled clean time  
is subject to removal and immediate disposal.**

YOU MAY REQUEST FREE STORAGE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY on the morning  
of the scheduled cleanup in person at the cleanup site thirty (30) minutes before the  
cleanup time. \* The District will provide you with up to two 40 - gallon containers to  
put your belongings in for storage. Perishable, soiled, wet, infested, illegal items  
and items unsafe or dangerous to handle will not be stored. Tents that are not  
soiled or wet, and that are taken down and folded, are eligible for storage.

**Property left on site during the cleanup is subject to removal and immediate disposal.**  
The District will store items of obvious value left on site, such as IDs, driver's licenses,  
passports, photographs, financial records, and other similar documents, medications,  
or working electronics, if they are in plain sight. **However, cleanup crews may be unable to  
identify or find these items. You leave property on site during the cleanup at your own risk.**
