A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO DEVELOP AND INSTALL SIGNAGE AS DEEMED NECESSARY FOR PROPER NOTIFICATION OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED CITY OF INDEPENDENCE GENERAL CLEANUP OF PUBLIC SPACES AND DEVELOPING PROVISIONS FOR THE STORAGE OF CERTAIN ITEMS.

WHEREAS, the City of Independence has experienced an increase in the number of calls for service from citizens regarding abandoned property; and,

WHEREAS, the City has expended substantial financial and human resources in pursuit of responding to abandoned property; and,

WHEREAS, abandoned property presents a number of adverse impacts, including blight, public health hazards and crime and disorder; and,

WHEREAS, Independence for All strives to achieve livability, choice, access, health and safety by reducing blight, improving the visual appearance of the community and improving public infrastructure and facilities; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to properly notify individuals within a reasonable period of time of when scheduled cleanups of public spaces will occur;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is directed to develop and install signage as deemed necessary for proper notification of regularly scheduled City of Independence general cleanup of public spaces.

SECTION 2. That these public spaces may include, but shall not be limited to, City parks and park facilities, City rights-of-way, City facilities and City-owned grounds.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is further directed to develop provisions for the storage of certain items deemed to be of value, including IDs, driver's licenses, passports, photographs, financial records and other similar documents.
