AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR THE PUBLIC TRANSIT OPERATING ASSISTANCE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,504.00 FOR OPERATING EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH TRANSIT SERVICE FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022; AND MAKING THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, the transit operating assistance from the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission is a program offered to cities and agencies providing fixed-route transit service in their respective service areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager of the City of Independence, Missouri, shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute in the name and on behalf of said City a certain agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission providing for public transit assistance in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Four and NO/100 Dollars (\$16,504.00) for the purpose of supporting bus service for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, to be reimbursed to the City of Independence, Missouri for the operation of local fixed route transit service, said grant agreement being substantially the same form as the copy attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That appropriations are hereby increased in the Community Development Department Operating Budget within the Grants Fund in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Four and NO/100 Dollars (\$16,504.00) for operating expenses associated with transit service from grant revenues received from the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for Public Transit Operating Assistance.
