Budget Survey Results


Background:

- Survey asked citizens to answer 5 questions
- 403 responses at closing


Question 1: Please rank this year's budget priorities from most important to least important.

- **57.7%** Accurately budget for all know costs
- **20.5%** Prepare appropriately for future spending based on conservative revenue estimates
- **12.1%** Address the adopted strategic priorities outlined in Independence for All and identified as part of this survey
- **9.7%** Strategic use of one-time revenues to navigate economic uncertainties


Paying for basic services like code enforcement, park maintenance, and street repairs.

Question 5: What other budget or service priorities do you feel have not been addressed?

Common responses:

<u>Utilities</u>- Upgrade infrastructure, Improve billing, Improve services provided to customers.

<u>Police-</u> decrease crime, increase officers, additional speed enforcement, new facility, address homeless population/panhandlers.

<u>Codes-</u> additional code enforcement, additional abatements, demolition of dangerous buildings.

Health and Animal Services- additional food inspections, additional staff for stray animals.

Streets- debris clean up, updating road conditions (potholes & overlay)
