

#### Blue Lawn Storm Drainage

 This project addressed residential flooding of homes located between 31st and 32nd Streets, east of Arlington Avenue in Rock Creek Watershed

 Blue Nile and Radmacher Brothers Exc. Installed over 2,100 feet pipe and 22 inlets including grading and site restoration

## Walnut Gardens Stormwater Phase 2

 In the Crackerneck Watershed, this project replaced undersized and inadequate drainage facilities to mitigate residential flooding between East 26th Terrace Court South and East 27th Terrace South, east of R.D. Mize Road

 Blue Nile and Lineaweaver Construction installed 1,007 feet of pipe and 13 inlet structures

## Crescent Meadows Stormwater CIP

- Located in a residential neighborhood of the Rock Creek Watershed, this project will mitigate flooding of six homes along Arlington Ave
- Construction began in February 2020 and was completed in December 2021
- The contractor was SDI
- Project contains over 500 feet of conduit, 8 inlet structures and 500 feet of improved channel

## Moore and Spring Drainage and Sanitary Sewer

 This combined stormwater and sanitary sewer project addressed flooding from overland flows along with sewer backups to the homes located along the intersection of Moore and Spring Streets

 305 feet of storm line with 7 new inlets plus 326 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewers with 3 new manholes were installed by City SMD staff and Wiedenmann Construction



## Truman at Harris Culvert Stabilization

 Located in Rock Creek Watershed, a culvert under Truman Road had been extended by adjacent business owners

 These extensions have structurally failed which threatened both the roadway and City utilities


 Improvements to the culvert consisted of the removal of the failed sections and rebuilding of the outlet barrel and wingwalls

2021 Emergency Project – 35th and Kiger


- An existing 72-inch diameter metal storm line under 35th Street has deteriorated and collapsed to the point that it threatened the road, utilities, and the adjacent residential properties
- The project has 70 feet of HDPE pipe and 2 new curb inlets
- Projected to be completed beginning of April 2022

# Bristol Storm Drainage Improvements

- Located in the Rock Creek Watershed, this project will address flooding of homes along Cedar from 15th to 14th Street
- V.F. Anderson is the Contractor and will have installed 1,173 feet of pipe and 18 inlet structures once completed
