AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2021- 2022 BUDGET, WHICH WAS APPROVED BY ORDINANCE NO. 19228.

WHEREAS, the adopted Operating and Capital budgets for the 2021-22 fiscal year were approved by the City Council by Ordinance No. 19228; and,

WHEREAS, since that time some circumstances have arisen that necessitate changes to the appropriations established in the adopted budget; and,

WHEREAS, these changes are listed in detail in terms of background, purpose and funding source in the attached agenda item cover sheet;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$21,858.44 from grants for Police programs and services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$21,858.44 to the Police Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
- SECTION 2. Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$77,750.00 in the General Fund (No. 002) from Unassigned Fund Balance for the General Municipal Election April 5, 2022, and a leadership program attended by the City Clerk.
- SECTION 3. Transferring appropriations of \$250,000.00 from Professional Services in the Operating Budget to Capital Improvement Project #131802 Emergency Repair projects within the Storm Water Sales Tax Fund (No. 013).
- <u>SECTION 4.</u> Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$30,039.84 from Police Forfeiture revenues in the General Fund (No. 002) to Police Forfeiture expenditures in the General Fund (No. 002).
- SECTION 5. Transferring appropriations of \$410,000.00 between various projects within the Power & Light Fund (No. 020).
- SECTION 6. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$1,118,580.00 from grants for Community Development for transit services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$1,118,580.00 to the Community Development Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
- <u>SECTION 7.</u> Transferring appropriations of \$882,519.76 between various projects within the Sanitary Sewer Fund (No. 030).
- <u>SECTION 8.</u> Transferring appropriations of \$306,138.04 between various projects within the Storm Water Sales Tax Fund (No. 013).
- <u>SECTION 9.</u> Transferring appropriations of \$594,744.95 between various projects within the Street Improvement Sales Tax Fund (No. 011).

- <u>SECTION 10</u>. Transferring appropriations of \$416.77 between projects within the Street Improvements Fund (No. 051).
- SECTION 11. Transferring appropriations of \$11,130.97 from Project #301806 in the Sanitary Sewer Fund (No. 030) to Project #131802 in the Storm Water Sales Tax Fund (No. 013).
- SECTION 12. Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$96,560.80 in the Street Improvements Fund (No. 051) from transfers out of the License Surcharge Fund (No. 014).
- <u>SECTION 13.</u> Transferring appropriations of \$543,930.00 between projects within the Water Fund (No. 040).
- SECTION 14. Increasing appropriations in the amount of \$14,159.78 from Unassigned Fund Balance in the Parks Improvements Sales Tax Fund (No. 012) for early repayment of the Interfund Loan owed to Water for the Farmer's Market.
- SECTION 15. Increasing revenues in the amount of \$291,500.00 from grants for Health & Animal Services in the Grants Fund (No. 015) and appropriating a total of \$291,500.00 to the Health & Animal Services Grants account in the Grant Fund (No. 015).
