Performance Expectations

Request: Audit all existing website pages

Response: Yes, we will audit all existing website content during Phase 1: Discover. We collaborate with you to inventory all existing content and determine what will move to the new site. We use a tailored deliverable called an Initial Content Manifest that enables us to clearly track what will happen with existing content (keep it, revise it, or leave it behind) and what new content will need to be created.

Request: Work with staff to determine what pages should be brought over to the new website

Response: Confirmed. See the answer above. Early in the project we will meet with your team and provide tools and guidance to help with this review.

Request: Convert/copy all identified content over to the new website

Response: Our database experts first assess whether anything can be migrated programmatically—this is typically limited to large amounts of data stored in a database or in a structured format (press releases, newsletters, etc.).

Manual content migration is woven into our training strategy. We have found that this collaborative effort is the most budget-friendly way to approach content migration and allows your staff to become familiar with the new site and how to use it. Once your new CMS is ready for content entry, your dedicated I.F. trainer will help your city web editors get to know the new site and the content entry and audit process. These trainings are conducted live via video conference and are recorded for reuse in bite-size, topical segments for future reference. Coursework includes:

- **Content Editor Training**: A detailed overview of the content editor experience and best practices for entering, revising, and maintaining content on the new site.
- **Site Administrator Training:** A separate, more in-depth training for your site administrators, customized to their level of expertise.
- **Content Audit Training:** Discovery of the process and tool to audit your content prior to launch, including training on the types of issues to look out for, easy fixes, and how to prioritize.

Then, with our support, your team enters content identified for manual migration and reviews all content to ensure it is ready for launch. Most clients prefer this approach, in which we provide detailed training and support, but your staff is responsible for the actual migration of content.

You can also select our optional Expanded content services for increased support to your team for additional content migration and writing support services.



Request: New content will be drafted with support from City staff

Response: We train you on best practices for creating web content, help write content for new high-level pages and revise high-priority content to support user success. Any additional new content will be written by City staff, with feedback from I.F. available, and using content tools that we will tailor for your specific needs.

For additional support, we recommend our optional Expanded Content Services, which can include us drafting or editing content directly or providing additional in-depth coaching for your staff. The reason for this is straightforward: We want you to be self-sufficient when it comes to content on your site. But we are always available to help, either through the Expanded Content Services option (during implementation) or through our Evolution & Support plan.

Request: Provide html templates, css and graphics that can be used to make our in house developed applications match the new website

Response: Yes, we will provide you with HTML, CSS, and graphics that the City can use to make in-house applications match the new website. Our scope of work excludes, however, the implementation of these components on your applications. We can assist with this if you so desire and are open to discussion on how. Note we haven't included this in our recommended options at this time.



Follow-Up Questions

Question: Now that you have learned more about the project are there any changes to the proposed project schedule?

Answer: No. We anticipate being able to launch your new website in approximately 36 weeks from kickoff.

Q: The City would like to be the account holder for the AWS hosting account. We would like to confirm that this will not be a problem.

Answer: Fulcrum is a fully managed municipal-specific hosting solution that utilizes AWS as the underlying infrastructure. There are multiple layers of functionality integrated with AWS to provide a highly available, secure platform. Direct access to AWS is not allowed at a client level. This allows us to provide both superior uptime guarantee and performance. It is a fully managed service, including security updates and patches. Your team can rest assured that we have you covered.

If direct access to the servers is necessary, we recommend you to explore either:

- self-host, which we are able to support as an option already provided in the proposal, or;
- dedicated Fulcrum hosting instance where we would be able to share AWS login credentials.

Over the last ten years, we have had only two customers needing a dedicated instance of Fulcrum—both large government entities (including a state government) many times the City's size which needed specific security measures to interoperate (ATO) with US federal government systems. As such, the cost for dedicated Fulcrum instances was higher.

Should you be concerned with continuity of operations, for other clients we have created backups (of the Drupal codebase and files) in a compressed format; such backups could be created and provided to you on a regular basis via the I.F. Evolution & Support plan.



Best and Final Price

Below and on the following pages, you'll find our best and final price for all items listed in our original proposal. Items in red text have been modified to reflect a discount or alternative pricing approach for the City. Should the City be willing to sign a multi-year (minimum 3 year) agreement with Interpersonal Frequency, we would be happy to waive the annual 5% cost increases so long as the City renewed at the same or higher levels on both Fulcrum cloud hosting and the Evolution & Support plans.

Optional Features

The below are our recommendations based on your questions and the interview, as well as common requests from other comparable city customers.

Recommended Optional Features

Expanded Site search: This option is for more advanced search features, such as including the contents of PDF documents in site search, and potentially other file types (e.g., MS Word). Note: this option requires further technical scoping and may require additional subscription software expenses not listed here.	\$7,500
Advanced Integration Services: For example, making an API call to display information on the website natively and allow users to perform certain functions. Note: these services may require enabling additional functionality in your hosting environment, including AuthScale in our Fulcrum cloud. Pricing for this additional functionality would be determined separately. Based on our review of your current integrations (RecTrack, CitySourced, CIS Infinity Link, Validity, Lucity, YouTube, Google Maps and several in-house developed applications) we recommend accounting for several possible advanced integrations.	\$10,000 per API (Recommended for advanced seamless integrations forRecTrack, CitySourced, CIS Infinity Link, Validity, Lucity)
Third-Party Webform Integration: Our Standard Scope of Work includes the creation of up to 3 forms and training on how to create more within Drupal.
