THIS SUB-AWARDEE AGREEMENT (the "AGREEMENT") is made by and between the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority (hereafter "KCATA"), a body corporate and politic, and a political subdivision of the States of Missouri and Kansas, with offices at 1350 East 17th Street, Kansas City, Missouri, and the City of Independence, Missouri (hereafter "SUB-AWARDEE") with offices at 111 E. Maple Avenue, Independence, Missouri, 64050.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021, which President Biden signed on March 11, 2021 to support the nation's public transportation systems as they continue to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and the ARP formula funding is being disbursed through <u>FTA apportionments</u> to its Urbanized Area;

WHEREAS, the KCATA, the designated recipient of Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Funds (hereafter "5307 Formula Funds") and the SUB-AWARDEE, pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 are authorized to enter into this AGREEMENT pertaining to federal funding committed for Section 5307 - ARP Act Formula Grants for Urbanized Areas under the jurisdiction of the KCATA; and

WHEREAS, the KCATA has sub-allocated ARP Act Formula grant funds to the Sub-Awardee made available to the KCATA under 49 United States Code (hereinafter, "USC") 5307 (hereinafter, "5307"), to defray a portion of the costs of a general

public transportation project carried out by the SUB-AWARDEE, and pursuant to the American Rescue Act under PL 116-136, March 27, 2020 (hereinafter, "ACT") for "Transit Infrastructure Grants", in the amount of \$1,749,322 to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to The ARP Act and any subsequent annual appropriations bills, additional public funds are available for programs to support public transit systems, and the KCATA is authorized by law to reimburse the SUB-AWARDEE with these public funds; and

WHEREAS, KCATA is the primary recipient of funding under Federal Transit Administration (hereafter "FTA") Project MO-2022-021-00, and the responsible entity for the disbursement of federal project funding; and

WHEREAS, the SUB-AWARDEE's Project for Operations and Maintenance Assistance (hereafter "PROJECT") is consistent with the region's Coordinated Public Transit Plan; and the SUB-AWARDEE's Project detailed below is included in FTA grant MO-2022-021-00;

WHEREAS, the SUB-AWARDEE agrees that if it receives Federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, a different Federal agency, or insurance proceeds for any portion of a project activity approved for FTA funding under this Grant Agreement, it will provide written notification to FTA, and reimburse FTA for any Federal share that duplicates funding provided by FEMA, another Federal agency, or an insurance company.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of these mutual covenants and promises herein set forth, the KCATA and the SUB-AWARDEE agree as follows:

Operating funds will cover expenses for existing service incurred beginning January 20, 2020 until December 31, 2023.

Total Federal Ceiling: \$1,749,322

<u>Local Match</u>: The project is funded at 100% Federal of the total eligible project costs. There is no local match required.

PROJECT PERFORMANCE PERIOD: January 20, 2020 to December 31, 2023

This project does not include any indirect costs.

This project does not include research development costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of these mutual covenants and promises herein set forth, the KCATA and the SUB-AWARDEE agree as follows:

- **1.** This AGREEMENT is effective as of the last date affixed below by the signatory KCATA and the SUB-AWARDEE.
- 2. The SUB-AWARDEE shall proceed with implementation of the PROJECT, as detailed in KCATA's grant application, MO-2022-021-00. The SUB-AWARDEE shall at all times comply with all applicable FTA requirements outlined in Appendix A of this agreement and guidelines. In the event of any noncompliance by SUB-AWARDEE with FTA requirements and guidelines that creates an obligation to repay grant funds to the FTA, it will be the SUB-AWARDEE's obligation to make such repayment, and the SUB-AWARDEE will indemnify KCATA against and hold KCATA harmless from any obligation or liability with respect to such repayment.
- 3. THE KCATA shall reimburse the SUB-AWARDEE for eligible costs of implementing said PROJECT at the participation rate and subject to the funding ceiling delineated above. The SUB-AWARDEE shall submit reimbursement requests to KCATA no more frequently than monthly. All costs to be reimbursed under this AGREEMENT shall be supported by sufficient documentation evidencing that those costs were specifically incurred and paid. All documentation of eligible reimbursable costs shall be clearly identified and readily accessible.
- **4.** The SUB-AWARDEE agrees to supply quarterly reports required by KCATA, utilizing report forms supplied or approved by the KCATA. Quarterly Reports shall be submitted by the 15th of the month following calendar quarters ending in December, March, June and September. These reports include: Program Performance Report reporting any issues, ridership activity and a Project Expenditure Report.

All reports and submissions to KCATA from the SUB-AWARDEE concerning this AGREEMENT shall be sent to:

5. The SUB-AWARDEE may be subject to the audit requirements of 2 CFR 200 (Previously OMB Circular A-133), if the SUB-AWARDEE had Federal award expenditures of \$750,000 or more in the past fiscal year. If the \$750,000 threshold under 2 CFR 200 has been met the SUB-AWARDEE shall cause, at its own expense, to have an audit completed and will submit the audit report and any management letter issued by the auditor and corrective action plan addressing all findings and questioned costs to the audit clearinghouse found at https://harvester.census.gov/facweb/.

KCATA is responsible for reviewing the audit report and issuing a management decision on any audit findings pertaining to funding received from KCATA within six (6) months of receipt of the audit report and ensuring that the SUB-AWARDEE takes appropriate and timely corrective action.

- **6.** The SUB-AWARDEE binds themselves, their successors, assignees, contractors, executors and administrators in respect to all covenants of this AGREEMENT. The SUB-AWARDEE shall not sign, sublet or transfer their interest in this AGREEMENT without the written consent of KCATA.
- 7. This AGREEMENT represents the entire and integrated agreement between parties regarding the Project Funds in the Total Federal Ceiling and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, either written or oral. This AGREEMENT may be amended only by written instrument signed by all parties. The AGREEMENT can be terminated by SUB-AWARDEE when SUB-AWARDEE has received and paid to others the lesser of (i) the Total Federal Ceiling, or (ii) the entire amount of money that KCATA has paid to SUB-AWARDEE.
- **8.** KCATA's grant application/FTA Agreement, MO-2022-021-00, Contract Conditions/Federal Requirements, U.S. Department of Labor Certification, links to the FTA Master Agreement and Certifications and Assurances documents, Lobbying Certification and all applicable Federal, State and Local statutes and regulations are incorporated into this AGREEMENT by this reference and are binding upon KCATA and the SUB-AWARDEE.
