## EXTENSION AND AMENDMENT AGREEMENT

**THIS EXTENSION AND AMENDMENT** ("<u>Extension</u>") is made and entered into as of the \_\_\_\_\_ day of December, 2022 by and between the City of Independence, Missouri ("<u>City</u>") and First Transit, Inc. ("First Transit").

**WHEREAS,** the parties entered into that certain Agreement for Professional Services, dated July 1, 2017 (the "<u>Agreement</u>"); and

**WHEREAS,** the parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement and amend certain provisions thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Extension and Amendment, and good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties mutually agree as follows:

- 1. <u>TERM</u>. Pursuant to Section 7 of Exhibit C to the Agreement, the parties can extend the term of the Agreement upon the same terms and conditions in the Agreement, and First Transit has submitted pricing more than 180 days prior to the end of the initial term. The parties hereby agree to an extension of the term of the Agreement for one (1) year commencing July 1, 2023 and continuing through June 30, 2024 ("Extension Term").
- 2. <u>PRICING</u>. The pricing for the Extension Term is set forth on Exhibit B attached hereto, which shall be the new Exhibit B to the Agreement and replace in its entirety any previous Exhibit B. Pricing set forth on Exhibit B is contingent upon a service volume of no less than 14,050 hours. If the service volume falls below 14,050 hours, the parties will negotiate in good faith for new pricing terms. Marketing Fee costs have been removed from the 2023 / 2024 agreement. In the event marketing materials are needed and First Transit is required to provide them, the City will reimburse First Transit for actual costs incurred.
- 3. <u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>. Except as may be expressly defined herein, (i) all words in this Extension and Amendment shall have the same meanings as in the Agreement and (ii) all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. This Extension and Amendment shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties, their successors and assigns. In the event of a conflict between this Extension and Amendment shall govern.
