

RESOLUTION BILL NO. 90-550RESOLUTION NO. 3503A RESOLUTION CREATING A CITY EMPLOYEES' STAY WELL
HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE CITY
MANAGER AND APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Independence, Missouri, wishes to create a City Employees' Staywell Health Advisory Committee to serve in an advisory capacity to the City Manager for the employees' Stay Well Health Insurance Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Committee has been operating in an unofficial capacity for a year and has been very successful and helpful to the City Manager, and employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Independence, Missouri, desires to officially establish the committee to assist the City Manager and to continue their involvement in the review of the Stay Well Health Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Employees' Stay Well Health Advisory Committee is hereby officially established to act in an advisory capacity to the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That the members of the Stay Well Health Advisory Committee shall serve representing the various employee groups of the City and be appointed for three year staggered terms with the first term expiring July 1, 1992. Vacancies shall be filled through appointment by the City Manager with recommendations from participants in the Stay Well Health Plan.

SECTION 3. That representatives from each of the following employee groups will serve in a capacity as voting members and shall elect a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary.

- 1 - International Association of Firefighters, Local #781
- 2 - Service Employees International Union (Clerical/Maintenance)
- 1 - United Steelworkers
- 1 - International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers
- 1 - Fraternal Order of Police
- 2 - Non-bargaining group employees


SECTION 4. That a representative from the following group will serve in a capacity as a voting member and will be appointed by the City Council.

- 1 - Independence, Missouri Lagers Retirees, Chapter 1


SECTION 5. That one employee member will serve in a non-voting capacity as follows:

A staff liaison between the City and the Third Party Administrator operating in an Ex-Officio capacity


