SUBJECT: MoDOT Highway Safety Division Grant Applications

The grant applications to the MoDOT Highway Safety Division have been submitted online at the MoDOT website prior to the March 1st, 2023 deadline. These are the ongoing traffic safety grants that are renewed each year. These grant requests are for the 2023/2024 grant year beginning October 1st, 2023 and ending September 30th, 2024.

In addition to the online submission, the attached original hard copy applications require Chief Dustman's signature. The attached authorization form requires approval by the City Manager. This paperwork will be submitted by mail and accepted by MoDOT Highway Safety Division after the March 1st, 2023 deadline for online submission.

These grants were requested to be fully funded through MoDOT with no matching funding responsibility from the department. When the grant period expires, there is no further obligation to continue these projects, and no other costs will be incurred.
