RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE KANSAS CITY AREA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING TRANSIT SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2022, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to continue Inter- and Intra-City paratransit services for the welfare and convenience of the certified disabled citizens of Independence; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires for KCATA to provide transit management services that include managing the City's contract with First Transit Corporation for fixed route public transportation within the City of Independence; and,

WHEREAS, in June 2022, the City Council approved a contract with KCATA in the amount of \$135,000 and authorized additional funding of \$13,500.00 for minor change orders as deemed appropriate; and,

WHEREAS, paratransit ridership has increased necessitating the need to authorize additional funding of \$30,000.00 for the remainder of this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is authorized to approve future minor change orders to the Contract, as may be necessary to complete the project; without Council approval, as long as the total of such change orders does not exceed Thirty Thousand, and NO/100 Dollars (\$30,000.00), the funds necessary for said change orders are in fact available, and provided a copy of each change order is approved by the City Manager, is identified as being authorized by this ordinance and is filed with the City Clerk.
