DNR REGULATION CLAUSE
REGARDING BACKFLOW PREVENTION**

Effective January 1, 1987 the Missouri Department of Natural Resources has adopted a new regulation governing the installation and testing of backflow preventers. The regulation is contained in the Missouri Administrative Code, Chapter 10 CSR, Section 10.040, and is hereby incorporated by reference into this contract. The regulation is as follows:

1. The purpose of this regulation is to protect the public health and safety by preventing the backflow of contaminated water into the public water supply.

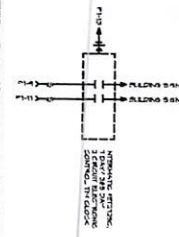
